

Tuxedo Instructions for the Groom

1. **Measurements** – The men in the wedding party should all be measured using the form provided. The length of the pants should be measured without shoes to the floor, minus one inch.
2. **Role of the Best Man** – It is a good idea to appoint your best man as the key contact. He or some other designee should coordinate the return of the tuxedos no later than the Tuesday after your wedding.

Please Note – Tuxedo or tuxedo parts must be returned by the Tuesday after the wedding or a \$22.00 per day charge is assessed by Ascot/Al's Formal wear. Stardust can not waive this fee.

3. **Arrival of Tuxedos** – StarDust receives the tuxedos on the Wednesday before the wedding. A Stardust staff member will notify the groom. The groom must notify all the men in his wedding party. We ask that the groom be the first person in to inspect the tuxedo style and approve all the pieces.
4. **Required Try On** – There is a good chance that the tuxedo will need some minor alterations. We are happy to do those at no charge. Please make sure all the men in the wedding party try on the tuxedo to avoid an ill-fitting tuxedo.
5. **Reorders and Pick ups** – Measuring for a tuxedo is imprecise and we often must order a new shirt, a new jacket, etc. The following table is the deadline for reorders:

For Saturday evening weddings - 3:00 Friday for last reorders. Pickup time is after 1:00 pm on Saturday.

For Saturday morning or early afternoon weddings, 3:00 Thursday for last reorders. Pick up is after 1:00 PM on Friday

6. **About the Fit** – Rental tuxedos rarely fit as well as a purchased suit. As a matter of fact, if each man in the wedding party personally selected a tuxedo to purchase, he would chose a style that flatters his shape, not that of the other men. Please help the men in your wedding party understand that we will try our best to ensure that they are comfortable and that they will look wonderful.
